About APWS

Asia-Pacific Water Summit (APWS) is the summit-level conference for top government leaders in the region, focusing on water issues and sustainable development, which is organized by the Asia-Pacific Water Forum (APWF) and a host country government.

The APWF is an independent and not-for-profit network organization. It was established by calling for creation of such network at the 4th World Water Forum (2006) and has devoted since then to identify and adopt solutions to water-related issues in the Asia-Pacific region.

Past Achievement

The 1st APWS, the first-ever international water conference for top government leaders in the region focusing on water issues, was hosted by the Government of Japan (Beppu, 2007) and the 2nd APWS was hosted by the Government of Thailand (Chiang Mai, 2013).

The 1st APWS

- Period: 3-4 December, 2007 Host Country: Japan
- Place: Beppu City, Oita Prefecture
- •Theme: Water Security: Leadership and Commitment
- •Invitees and Participants: A total of 371 participants, including 10 heads of state/government and 32 ministerial-level dignitaries
- •Outcomes: "Message from Beppu" to accelerate the attainment of universal access to safe water and sanitation by 2025 beyond the MDGs, as the firs-ever adoption of the water disaster being part of water issues at a summit-level conference, corresponding to significant risk of water-disaster in the region.

The 2nd APWS

- •Period: 19-20 May, 2013
- · Host Country: Thailand
- ·Place: Chiang Mai
- •Theme: Water Security and Water-related Disaster Challenges, Leadership and Commitment
- •Invitees and Participants: Over 300 participants, including 18 heads of state/government and 16 ministerial-level dignitaries
- •Outcomes: "Chiang Mai Declaration" to express the strong will in addressing solutions to water supply and sanitation issues as well as disaster risk reduction, by incorporating them into the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
